New Programs Announced for the 2010 RMPC!

It is our core philosophy at UE that sound risk management practices can reduce the frequency and severity of claims. We are committed to helping our members control their losses, and we offer hundreds of resources to help them do so.

Members who take advantage of UE's practical, education-oriented products and services and reduce campus risks can earn points toward a four percent credit on their renewal premium through the Risk Management Premium Credit (RMPC) program.

UE is excited to announce that in 2010, two new programs will be added to the list of qualifying activities for which members can earn points toward a premium credit. These programs are:

Alcohol Abuse Prevention: With more than 1,700 student deaths each year due to alcohol, implementing robust and effective alcohol prevention programs is a key element of education risk management and student safety. UE members can now enjoy a 15% discount off program costs and earn credit for implementing AlcoholEdu for College or AlcoholEdu for High School. These alcohol abuse prevention programs were developed by Outside The Classroom. Randomized control trials have documented the programs' efficacy in reducing negative outcomes associated with high-risk drinking.

Chief Academic Officer Training: The American Council on Education (ACE) offers practical leadership development training to Chief Academic Officers new to their role within the past three years. The yearlong program identifies topics and issues of immediate concern to new academic vice presidents and provides the means to address them. The ACE Institute for New Chief Academic Officers can be done as an alternative to running "The Goal Is Fairness" program, which also earns premium credit.

UE and OTC Announce Partnership to Provide Alcohol Risk Management Services

United Educators and Outside The Classroom (OTC) are collaborating to increase the use of alcohol abuse prevention programs among UE member institutions.

Understanding the impact of alcohol on education, UE is committed to focusing our membership on effective prevention strategies aimed at reducing the alcohol risk.

What This Means For UE Members:

UE members will receive a 15% discount off the cost of the AlcoholEDU for either K12 schools or higher education. Also, as noted above, an institution's implementation of AlcoholEdu is now a qualifying activity for UE's Risk Management Premium Credit. Additionally, OTC has provided significant training to UE risk management staff on alcohol prevention programming and effective strategies for reducing the alcohol risk so that we are prepared to assist our members as they develop such a program.
